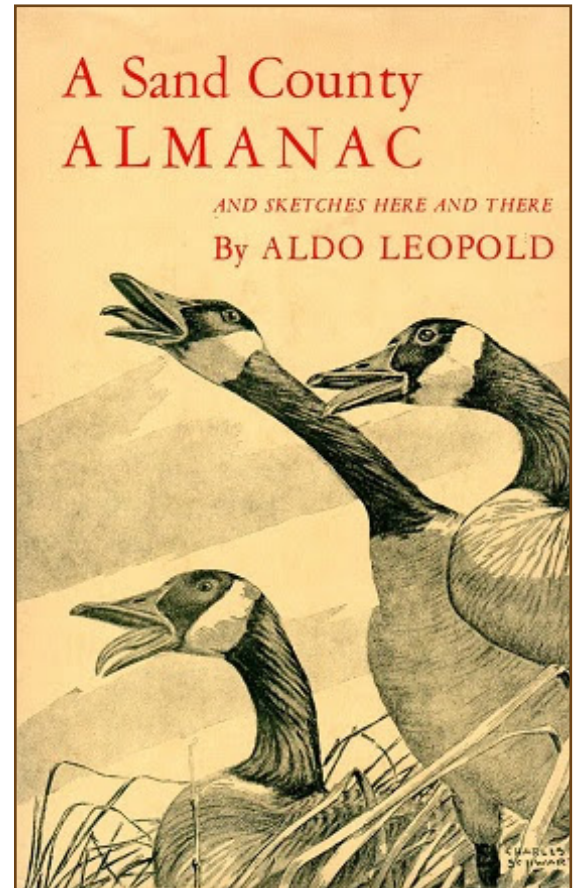


Land Library Summer Book Club at Buffalo Peaks Ranch
